We continue to have 3 small groups working at Duggan Park on separate days per month to maintain the bush. We have requested more plants for planting and are asking the students to plant and maintain these plants.

In the Millenium Forest we have cleared much lantana along the edge and are considering what we could replace the lantana with.
