



Leopard Ash Bushland Park Plant List

A key feature of this type of ecosystem is a great diversity of species. There are not one or several canopy trees which dominate the canopy, such as one finds in Australian woodlands or sclerophyll forests. Smaller trees, shrubs, some herbs and grasses and vines make up the remainder of this type of ecosystem. An intact semi-evergreen vine thicket is very dense and a superb haven for fauna. Trees and shrubs found in this ecosystem typically have hard smallish leaves and are slow growing.
