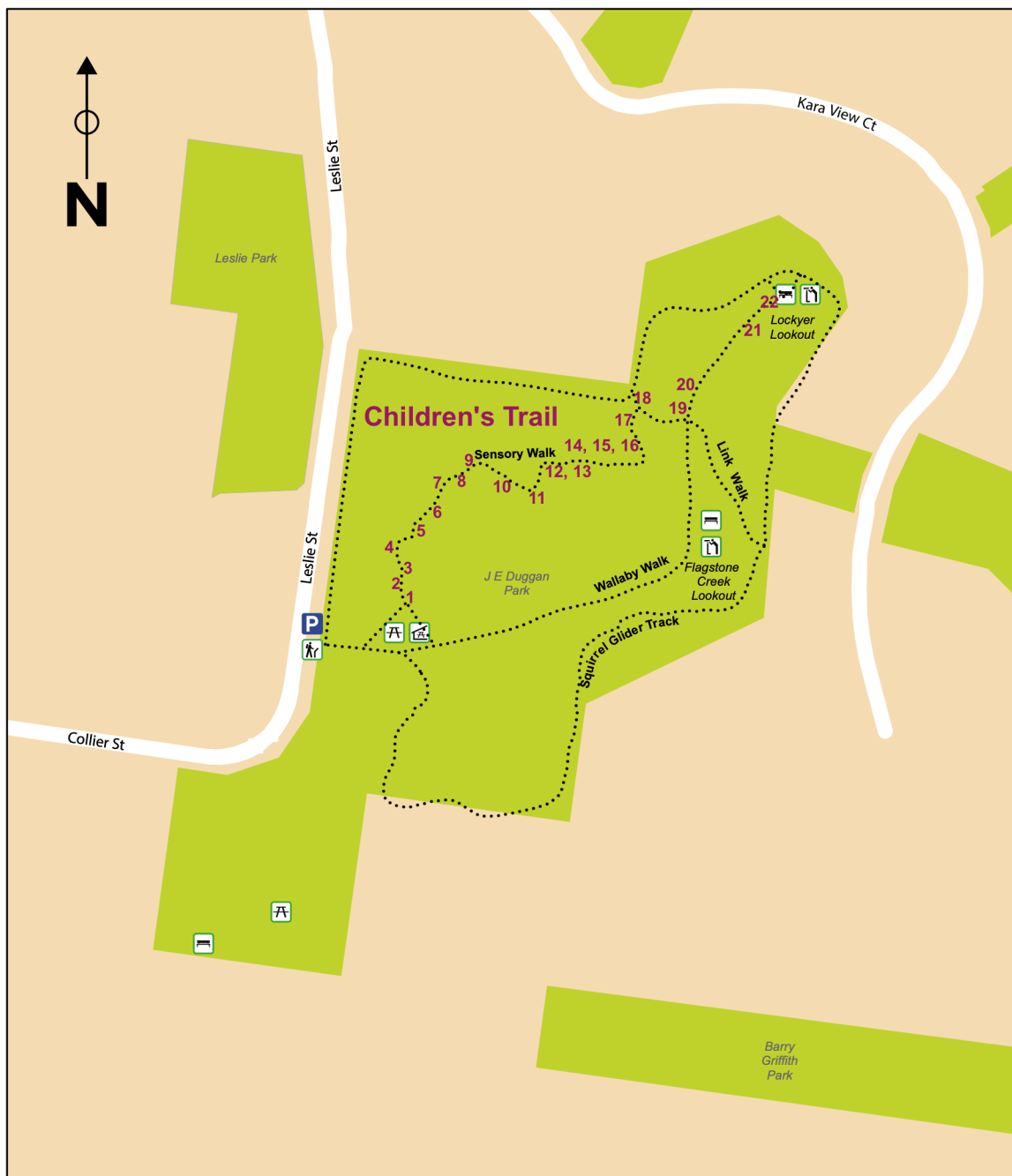




# Carnival in the Bush Children's Trail
